

## PETITION FOR LATE WITHDRAWAL FROM A COURSE

Petitions for a late withdrawal from a course (after the eleventh week of classes) must be approved by the Standards and Standing Committee to be processed. In addition, support by both the professor and the faculty advisor is required for this withdrawal petition to be considered. No petition for withdrawal from a class will be considered after the last day of classes.

A petition for a late withdrawal from a course will be considered only when extenuating circumstances prevented the student from withdrawing from the course by the deadline to do so. Ignorance of the deadline or of the withdrawal policy are not acceptable reasons. There must be valid reasons for withdrawing from the course at the late date and for why the petition to withdraw is being submitted after the official deadline. Those reasons must be explained below or on an attached sheet of paper.
