Students seeking to fulfill the F11 with a faculty-supervised research, creative, or professional experience must submit this completed contract to the Registrar's Office <u>by the end of the Add Period</u> in the term they expect F11 to be awarded. Students may earn F11 for completing <u>138 hours</u> of a supervised research, creative, or professional experience in one of two ways:

- Earn three (3) credits of 451/452 Research Practicum (1 credit = 46 hours of work)
- Complete **138 hours** of faculty-supervised research, creative, or professional activity as an Undergraduate Fellow

# Supervised Research, Creative, or Professional Experience F11 Assessment

Students seeking to fulfill the F11 with a faculty-supervised research, creative, or professional experience need to complete this assessment with their faculty supervisor upon completion of **138 hours** of supervised work. The Chair will submit the completed assessment to the Registrar's Office by the last day of the semester's grading period. IMPORTANT: For seniors in their final term at Rhodes, the assessment is due on the last day of the Withdraw Period. There are two student learning outcomes for F11 experiences:

- Participate in an authentic, faculty-supervised research or creative activity that results in professional engagement with the field (e.g. conference presentation, peer reviewed manuscript, juried exhibit or performance) and complements and broadens the student's program of study and prepares the student for graduate study or a career.
- > Develop research, creative, or professional skills used by professionals in the relevant field.

### F11 Sustained Engagement: Connect academic study to community, global, or professional engagement.

Sustained engagement involves developing the knowledge, skills, competencies, and values that prepare students to be thriving professionals and engaged members of local and global communities. Rhodes students become engaged citizens through involvement in activities related to their academic interests and professional goals. Sustained engagement to fulfill the F11 requires a minimum of 138 hours (equivalent to three Rhodes credits) and includes credited and non-credited experiences with measurable student learning outcomes. Although professional, community, and global engagement are not mutually exclusive activities, professional engagement normally includes paid and unpaid academic internships, working in research labs,-ROTC military training, and Career Practical Training (CPT); community engagement includes student fellowships, community-based research, and Rhodes courses and certificates with community-based learning components; global engagement includes study abroad/away experiences.
