

REQUEST FOR LATE WITHDRAWAL FROM A COURSE

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

Requests for a late withdrawal from a class (after the ninth week of classes) must be approved by the Standards and Standing Committee in order to be official. In addition, support of both the professor and the faculty advisor is required in order for this request to be considered. The student making this request should continue to attend the class in question until notified of a final decision by the Committee. No request for withdrawal from a class will be considered after the last day of classes.

A request for a late withdrawal from a class will be considered only when extenuating circumstances prevented the student from withdrawing from the class by the deadline to do so. Ignorance of the deadline or of the withdrawal policy are not acceptable reasons. There must be valid reasons for withdrawing from the course at the late date and why the request to withdraw is being submitted after the official deadline. Those reasons must be explained below or on an attached sheet of paper.

Cont. Request for Late Withdrawal from a Course
